EVACUATION PROCEDURE



The **Emergency Response Officers (ERO)** and the **Security** aboard the ship are responsible for the evacuation and safety of our guests.



If the evacuation alarm (**slow-whoop**) go off, then will take place an evacuation so all guests must leave the ship.



Guests are guided off the ship by using **various (emergency) exits** by the emergency response officers. Please get familiar with the location of these exits.



Once outside, on the **left-hand side of the quay** is the assembly point at the rear of the ship.



The **head of the ERO** will take the responsibility to inform the guests when it is **safe to re-enter** the ship.

ILLNESS OF A GUEST



If a guest **feels ill** or has **become unwell**, this can be reported to **Security** on the **Main Deck**.



The **Emergency Response Officers (ERO)** on board will be **informed** about the situation.



If necessary, the guest will be taken to the **First Aid room** on the Main Deck.



The **head of ERO** will **call an ambulance** if the situation requires it.
